• **Credit Retrieval Classes:**

1. All subjects offered
2. Minimum of six students per subject
3. Date: June 22 thru August 14
4. Monday thru Thursday
5. Time: 9:00am to 12:00pm
6. Cost: \$350.00 per half credit class plus supplies if needed

• **Full Credit Retrieval:**

1. Same dates apply
2. Monday thru Thursday
3. Time: 9:00am to 12:00pm and 1:00 to 4:00pm
4. Afternoon time is for those students needing a full credit retrieval only
5. Cost: \$700.00 per full credit class plus supplies if needed

• **Enrichment Classes:**

1. All subject taught for enrichment only, no credit given
2. Two weeks in length
3. Date and time to be discussed with teacher in advance
4. Enrichment classes can be fun as well such as: guitar, Marine Biology, etc.
5. Cost: \$150.00
6. May require supplies

*All funds will need to be collected before or the first day of class June 22nd.
