Parking Lot Guidelines

Please enter the parking lot from the designated enter drive (south) and exit through the designated exit (north) driveway. All preschool and childcare parents **MUST** park, walk their child to class, and sign their child in and out of the class. Please park in the gravel lot if you are walking your child to class. **Do not park on the blacktop.** When parking please do not block anyone else in. **DO NOT leave your car running.**

If your are dropping off or picking up an elementary student, you may pull through and drop off at the cones.

Our main concern is the safety of our children around the cars. **Please slow down and watch out for the children.**



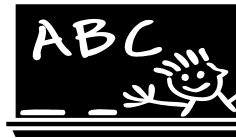
Elementary Lunch

Childcare will be available.

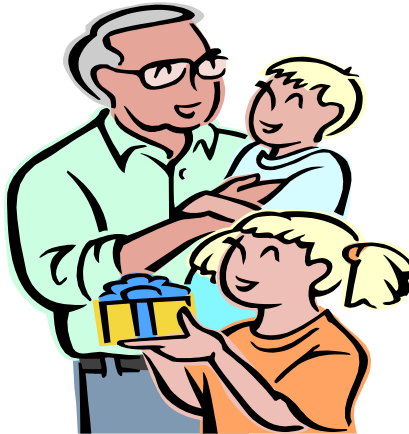
Chapel Day Is Thursday!

Picture packet information will come home the week before.



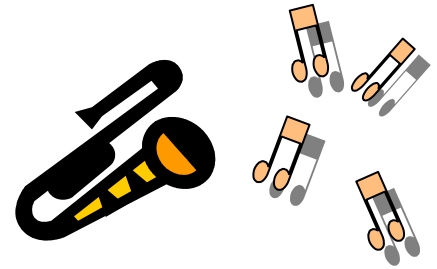
Teacher In-Service
