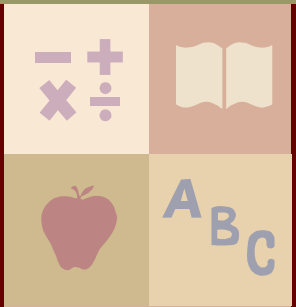

Please don't hesitate to call the office or stop Mrs. Johnson in the parking lot with questions regarding this event. We are looking forward to seeing each one of you.

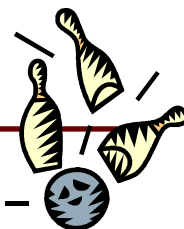
Needed Items
